The pool is cleared 15 minutes prior to closing time to allow patrons adequate time to shower and change prior to the closing of the pool.

Lap Swim will be open for patrons of all ages who are looking for the opportunity to exercise.

POOL RULES:

Please read these rules carefully as the Lifeguards on duty will strictly enforce them with no regard to race, nationality, creed, caste, religion, sex, gender, gender identity, age, etc.

- Bathing suits must be worn when in the water. T-Shirts may be worn over bathing suits if desired. **NO** street clothes, cut-offs, denim shorts, or thong bathing suits are permitted in the pool area, unless deemed appropriate for religious purposes.
- Sneakers are not permitted in the water. Rubber flip-flops and water shoes are permitted.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers.
- **NO** urinating or defecating in the pool.
- All bathers must take a shower in the locker room before entering the pool.
- **No** person will be permitted to enter the pool having: skin lesions; sores; inflamed eyes, nose, mouth; ear discharge; carrying communicable disease; having any type of bandage, adhesive tape, etc. on his/her body.
- The use of swimming aids, water toys, and floatation devices **is prohibited** – this includes water wings and inflatable rings.
 - Puddle Jumpers and Life Jackets are **the only** swim aids permitted.
- Electronics (including phones in water-proof cases) are not allowed in the water.
- Food is to be kept at the picnic tables. Glass bottles are not permitted within the grounds. Alcoholic beverages are **prohibited**.
- Gum must be deposited in the trashcan before entering the water.
- **NO** running on the concrete areas or stairs.
- **NO** pushing other patrons or Lifeguards either on land or into the water.
- **NO** dunking other patrons or Lifeguards.
- **NO** excessive rough play in the water or on land.
- **NO** horseplay in the shower or locker rooms.
- **NO** diving, except in designated areas.
- **NO** backward dives or flips off the edge of the pool.
- **NO** playing with or hanging on the barrier rope.
- **DO NOT** hang onto, play on, or jump off the ladders.
- **NO** smoking within the grounds. Smokers must not be visible from the pool area.
- **NO** pets within the grounds – service animals are the exception.
- Individuals who cannot swim only allowed in the shallow end of the pool. Before a patron is allowed in the deep end, he/she must pass a “deep end test” given by a Lifeguard. It is up to the discretion of the Lifeguard whether the patron passes and is allowed in the deep end.
- Obey **all** Lifeguard instructions; failure to do so may result in the patron being asked to leave the pool grounds.
- **EACH patron must have his/her OWN towel.**
- **Children 7 and under MUST be accompanied by an adult – NO EXCEPTIONS.**
