- Gene has mowed one pass on all roads throughout township.
- Davis Street Bridge is now scheduled to start July 25th, the town has cut brush and has all necessary equipment lined up, waiting for the county to get the equipment that is being used at another site.
- Brad met with Vestal Asphalt about the work they did last year, their oil and stone did not hold up on the roads. Vestal agreed to supply the asphalt and equipment and the Town will buy the gravel. They will be working on it this summer.
