6. **PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR/PUBLIC CONCERNS:**

- Scott Burt, attended the meeting to observe.
- Fred Cole addressed the board for approval of a project that he has been working on for a Vietnam Memorial in the Maple Lawn Cemetery. He presented a drawing of his plans and a basic idea on how they would raise money to pay for the monument by selling bricks engraved with veteran's name and information. The board approved his project to be put in the area designated for military monuments. An agreement for the board will be given by Fred, that any money made from the sale of the bricks over the cost of the monument and supplies, be turned over to the Bolivar Legion.

Highway:

- Superintendent Schiralli gave his report to the Board to review. The board discussed with Brad the four quotes given on the boiler for the new garage. Vision Contractor had the lowest quote, a motion to accept the quote was made by Supervisor Gould, seconded by Councilperson Ingalls Aye – 5, Nay – 0. Motion carried.
- Superintendent Schiralli would like to have their own radio channel, separate from the county; he has discussed splitting the cost with the Town of Genesee. The cost for each Town will be \$475. Supervisor Gould made the motion, seconded by Councilperson Iantorno to approve the radio channel if the Town of Genesee Board approves to share. Aye – 5, Nay – 0. Motion carried.

- The Maple Lawn Cemetery Rules & Regulation for Saturday, Sunday and Holiday burials were discussed. The board approved to charge an extra \$150.00 to the grave opening fee. An Open Public Hearing will be held on December 17th at 6:00pm in the Town Hall.
