Highway:

- Superintendent Schiralli gave his report to the Board to review, also an equipment report to keep the Board informed on the condition of each piece. The mowing tractor is still in poor condition and the Board would like Superintendent Schiralli to look into leasing compared to purchasing. The new garage work is slower now with the crew working on roads, the bathroom has a few little things to be put in and the break room has been wall boarded and painted. Superintendent Schiralli also has taken pictures of the trees and shrubs in the cemetery that need to be taken down because they are dead. He will be getting a quote from a tree service to take down the large trees.

- Town Hall Remodel ó The front counter has been re-covered, trimmed and painted. The swinging door has been reattached with a new small wall to the counter. The base of the walls have been fixed and repainted.
- The pool committees met to talk about the life guards and co-directors. They will have a second meeting to go over details with the co-directors on Thursday, June 19th.

11. NEW BUSINESS

- The Department of Social Services has given us a new JOBTRAK agreement. The program is used to clean the court room, town hall office and will add the new garage. A motion was made by Councilperson Iantorno, seconded by Councilperson Ingalls to enter into the agreement.

- The Fire Department would like to use a couple of town trucks to be used during the water fights, when the Firemenø Convention takes place. They would also like permission to park campers in the garage parking lot; the board was in favor of letting them use the parking lot.
