**Highway:**

- Superintendent Schiralli gave his report to the Board to review. The electric in the new building has been completed by the students at Alfred State College. All the lights have been hung and are functioning. The New York State electrical inspector came in Friday of last week to inspect the electric and passed it.

The town workers have been busy unthawing frozen sluice pipes for the last week, and have also started putting cold patch in potholes on many of our town roads.

- Town Hall Remodel: More tiles have been put down, the Village Clerk desk and the counter have been moved into a temporary spot so they can work on the flooring.
