- Justice: Justice Kirnan submitted his monthly report to the Board for the month of. Check #1047 for \$3,218.00 was deposited into the General A fund.
- Dog Control: Dog Control Officer Scott Fuller gave his report for December.
- Highway: Highway Superintendent Brad Schiralli gave his report to the Board.  
Mr. Schiralli states Ryan Loucks gave an estimate for materials and labor to put sliding doors on the portion of the Spang that the Town of Bolivar kept. The materials and labor has been approved by the Board.  
A highway employee got injured at home and is off work. His return to work is unknown at this time.

The new employees are doing well. They have started getting into a routine and are getting familiar with the town roads. The weather pattern so far this winter has taken a toll on some of the town roads. There will be plenty of maintenance to do come spring, especially on Kansas Hollow Road and Horse Run Road.
